By now you have elected officers, installed them, paid your bond. Your district dues are due by September 30. Make sure your Treasurer knows who to send the check to. All officers' dues must be paid by December 31. Your secretary or treasurer can check this. If their dues are not paid by December 31, they are no longer a member in good standing and cannot hold office.
