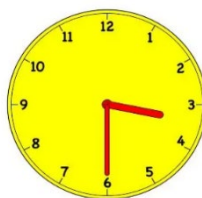
Let's be visible and show your pride in the VFW Auxiliary by wearing your attire (shirt, hat, jacket, name badge).
