Dear Sisters and Brothers,

My name is Jane Fox, and I am your Scholarship Program Chairman for 2022-2023. Many years ago, I was a single parent with no means of support to go back to school. I found a scholarship that fit my needs and got my degree in accounting. I was lucky, I only had one student loan to pay back. With the increase in college tuition, it is imperative that we get the word out about our scholarships. It has been very difficult to get into schools during Covid 19. We can do this; you need to come up with innovated ways to get this information to these students. When your Post and Auxiliary has your Awards Dinner make sure those winning students know to apply again next year. Call the Principal of your local schools, if you can't get inside then ask to set up a table outside with your Post Commander. Hand the scholarship flyers out to students and parents. This works. Send your flyers in the mail to the guidance counselors at the schools. Set a table out at your local grocery store. Have a relative invite you to a school function, hand out your flyers. Post scholarship flyers in windows of local stores. Just get the word out however you can. Call your local JROTC office, see if you can hand out the flyers. Contact your local nursing school or college, give them the Alice Hutto Scholarship information. Contact all your last year's winners. They will be most likely to submit application and essays again. Use your Face Book contacts that are not familiar with these scholarships. Use your sphere of influence.

Continuing Education Scholarship *This scholarship is open only to VFW Auxiliary members, their spouses, and their children. *The Auxiliary Member must have been a member for at least one year. *The applicant must be 18 years of age. * The applicant must write a brief essay (no more than 300 words) describing their commitment to their goals and how this scholarship will help them attain these goals. <https://vfwauxiliary.org/scholarships/continuing-education/>

Young American Creative Patriotic Art Contest *This contest recognizes up-and-coming artists and encourages patriotism in youth. *Open to students in grades 9-12 in public, private, parochial, or home school. *Entries will be judged on patriotic theme and technique. <https://vfwauxiliary.org/scholarships/young-american-creative-patriotic-art-contest/>

Voice of Democracy Audio-Essay Contest *The 2022-2023 theme is: "Why is the Veteran Important?" *Students should record their reading of the draft to an audio CD or flash drive. *The recording can be no shorter than three minutes and no longer than five minutes (plus or minus five seconds). <https://www.vfw.org/community/youth-and-education/youth-scholarships> Patriot's Pen Essay *The 2022-2023 theme is: "My Pledge to Our Veterans?" *This

Jan Owens JROTC Scholarship *Applicant must be a United States citizen and South Carolina resident. *Applicant must be a JROTC Cadet actively engaged in the JROTC program. *Applicant must include a statement of why they feel they should be awarded the scholarship.

Alice Hutto Memorial Scholarship Program *The applicant must have a 3.0 grade point average and have completed at least one semester at an accredited School of Nursing. *A list of personal reasons they should be chosen for the scholarship attached to the application. Recommended additions: --Endorsements from teachers, instructors, professors, and colleagues. These should include brief descriptions of individual accomplishments. --References from volunteer organizations in the community the applicant may have worked with, as well as extra-curricular pursuits.

Jan Owens JROTC Scholarship

This annual scholarship was initiated for the 2022-2023 Auxiliary year. It will be issued to a high school JROTC student that has been accepted at an institution of higher learning or a technical school for the 2023-2043 year. The scholarship will be in the amount of \$1,000.00 and will be issued to the institution.

Criteria:

1. Applicant must be a United States citizen
2. Applicant must be a resident of South Carolina
3. Applicant must be currently enrolled as a JROTC cadet actively engaged in the JROTC program and meets the criteria for the award a. Outstanding military bearing and conduct both in and out of uniform b. Personal attributes (self-confidence, initiative, flexibility, judgement) c. Courtesy (Dependability, punctuality, human relations, respect, cooperation)
4. We will need a letter of recommendation from the JROTC instructor
5. Applicant must have attained a grade of "B" in JROTC with an overall average of "C" on all subjects for the previous semester. Must not have a failing grade in any subject for the previous semester. School transcript must be provided.
6. Applicant must be active in at least one other student co-curricular activity or club i.e.: music, athletics, student government, junior achievement, etc.
7. Applicant must intend on furthering their education
8. Applicant will need to include a statement (not more than 400 words) of why they feel they should be awarded the scholarship.

Alice Hutto Memorial Scholarship Program

Department of South Carolina Veterans of Foreign Wars Auxiliary

Alice Hutto served as the Department President to the Veterans of Foreign Wars Department of South Carolina from 1989 to 1975. Alice was elected National President to the Veterans of Foreign Wars Auxiliary from South Carolina and served from 1989 to 1990.

On June 30, 1991, a fund was established in President Hutto's name when excess revenue from the National President's fund was returned to the Department Auxiliary. These funds were to be invested in a savings account or certificate of deposit.

The Council of Administration at the 2001 State Convention voted to use the revenue from this investment to provide a \$1000.00 Scholarship to assist an eligible nursing student to continue their education within the field.

Eligibility Requirements:

- * Applicants must be a United States Citizen.
- * The Applicant must have a 3.0 Grade Point Average and have completed at least one semester at an accredited School of Nursing.
- * A list of personal reasons they should be chosen for the scholarship attached to the application.
- * The Application and all documentation must be sent to the Department Chairman postmarked no later than April 15, 2023.

Recommended additions:

- * Endorsements from teachers, instructors, professors, and colleagues. These should include brief descriptions of individual accomplishments.
- * References from volunteer organizations in the community the applicant may have worked with as well as extra-curricular pursuits.
