*Examples Include

- Partnering with local police on child ID kits.
- Partnering with EMTs to host CPR training.
- Partnering with parks and recreation to plant trees
- Partnering with an animal shelter or neutering clinic
- Partnering with a local Soup Kitchen

- What's NOT Considered Auxiliary Outreach:
- Volunteer work that benefits the Post or Auxiliary
- Church activities for one specific congregation and not the entire community
- Serving on a board in your community like the school board, or board of trustees
