


THIS 2024-25 PRESIDENT BOOK IS DEDICATED TO MY WHY's:

Awards will be given to Outstanding Auxiliary members in the following categories. It should be known that all nominations may be submitted by more than one member of each Auxiliary if desired. Our members are doing the work. Let's see that they are recognized. Now is the time to show who "Never forgets our veterans!" All nominations must be sent to the Department President or appropriate officer no later than May 1, 2025.

Outstanding Auxiliary Chairman

One auxiliary chairman will receive recognition for outstanding performance during the 2024-2025 year. A summary report of why this chairman deserves to be recognized as outstanding chairman should be submitted. Criteria to be considered include planning, promotion, and achievement. The nomination may be prepared by the auxiliary president or any other officer or member of an auxiliary. These nomination letters need to be sent to the Department Program Coordinator – SuzAnne Taylor

Outstanding Auxiliary Member

Does your Auxiliary have one member who simply exemplifies the meaning and purpose of the VFW Auxiliary? An award will be presented to one auxiliary member based on his/her participation and initiative in auxiliary activities, membership recruitment, and his/her cooperation in dealing with Post and Auxiliary members, as well members of the community. This nomination may be prepared by any officer or member of an auxiliary and sent to the Department President – Donna Marie King.

Outstanding Auxiliary Secretary

The Outstanding Auxiliary Secretary award will be awarded based upon recommendations of Auxiliary President or any Auxiliary member. Secretaries may submit their own letter of achievement. A written recommendation on an Auxiliary Secretary that has gone above and beyond in their duties as an auxiliary secretary should be submitted. This includes ensuring that Secretary records are kept according to the Podium Manual and precise reports are given at each meeting. Must include helping to ensure that Auxiliary audits are reported on time and reports kept as a record in their minutes. Ensuring that all motions that are made and carried are written in the records with special attention to expenditures. This information can be judged on reports made at individual meetings. These nominations need to be sent to the Department Secretary – Lisa Levangie-Colon.

Outstanding Auxiliary Treasurer

The Outstanding Auxiliary Treasurer award will be awarded based upon recommendations of Auxiliary President or any Auxiliary member. Treasurers may submit their own letter of their achievements. Requires a written recommendation for an Auxiliary Treasurer that has gone above and beyond in their duties as an auxiliary treasurer. This includes ensuring that the Treasurer's records are kept according to the Auxiliary Podium Manual and precise reports are given at each meeting. Should also assist in helping to ensure that Auxiliary audits are reported on time. This information may be judged from reports made at individual meetings. These nominations need to be sent to the Department Treasurer – Jane Fox.

Outstanding Auxiliary President

An award will be presented to the Outstanding Auxiliary President, based on the following criteria:

- * Auxiliary must be 100% in membership by May 1, 2025.
- * Auxiliary President or his/her designee (Sr. Vice President or Jr. Vice President) must have attended all Council of Administration meetings, District meetings and other designated Department functions. This nomination requires a written report with recognition of outstanding performance as an Auxiliary President. Brag on the many things your Auxiliary President has been involved with during the year. Although not required, documentation is suggested. Award will be presented to one auxiliary president based on his/her participation and initiative in auxiliary activities, membership recruitment, and his/her cooperation in dealing with Post and Auxiliary members, as well members of the community. The nomination may be prepared by any officer or member of the auxiliary. These nominations need to be sent to the Department President Donna Marie King.

Outstanding District President

An award will be presented to the Outstanding District President, based on the following criteria:

- * District must be 100% in membership by May 1, 2025.
- * District President must have completed all auxiliary Official Visits.
- * District President or his/her designee (Sr. Vice President or Jr. Vice President) must have attended all Council of Administration meetings, District meetings and other designated Department functions.
- * District President or designee (Sr. Vice President or Jr. Vice President) must make a brief report at each Council of Administration Meeting with report provided to Dept. Secretary.
- * District President must submit an end of year report to the President no later than May 1, 2025, listing achievements of their District.
- * Must complete all requirements, information and reports pertaining to the Chief of Staff (Extension and Revitalization).
- * Must complete all requirements pertaining to the Jr. Vice President Liaison.

OPERATION CLASSROOM PATRIOTISM

We have found out that there is a need for flags and flag education in our elementary schools. When schools are trying to prepare their budget for the year to meet all needed requirements the budget gets cut in some areas. Flags are one of the first things removed from the budget. We need to promote patriotism in our youth, and supplying flags and flag education to our youth is a great way to instill that patriotism.

How can your Auxiliary complete this program?

- Go to your local elementary schools and find out how many classrooms need flags. (Most schools already have the bracket and poles – but check out if they need these items as well).
- 2. Determine how many flags you are going to provide. (Some schools may need flags in every classroom) You may decide to do all kindergarten classes or 1st grade classes etc.
- Purchase the flags required (poles and brackets if needed). In your packet at the SOI there
 will be a sheet provided of a flag company that sells classroom size flags at a reasonable
 cost.
- 4. Set up a day to go back to the school and present the flags to the classrooms and instruct the classes on flag etiquette. (Youth flag education sheet will be provided at the SOI, along with a sheet of book marks that you can copy to make enough to hand out).
- 5. Complete report form and send it to the Department President by April 15, 2025.

There is no money to be sent to the Department to fulfill this program. Part of this program is to get our Auxiliaries out into the schools and form relationships that will be beneficial to both the school and us.

CANCER AWARENESS



In the United States, 1 in 2 men and 1 in 3 women will be diagnosed with cancer in their lifetime. Cancer is the second leading cause of death worldwide, with millions of new cases and deaths each year. It does not just affect the individuals diagnosed, it ripples through families, communities, and entire nations.

For many people, cancer can be treated successfully. In fact, more people than ever before are leading full lives after cancer treatment.

As we look towards the future, the predicted increase in cancer cases and deaths, especially in low- and middle-income countries, calls for an urgent response in cancer care, prevention, and research initiatives.

My special project is Cancer Awareness. My request is to have someone who recognizes the ravages for cancer, either a professional organization or someone with personal experience to present an awareness program at our post.
